As writers we will be...

Learning to adapt our writing to suit three different text types. These will be cinquains, information texts and fantasy portal stories. These will allow the children to practise writing a form of poetry and understand the structural features of non-fiction texts. They will then be able to develop their creative writing using different descriptive techniques and grammatical features.

As mathematicians we will be...

Developing our understanding of decimals looking at ordering and comparing them and making wholes out of tenths and hundredths, We will also be looking at money, time, shape and statistics. The most important part of maths this term will be times tables and our times tables test.

In MFL we will be...

Learning how to say different dates including our birthdays. We will also learn about family, clothes, different French stories and food project. We will continue to practise our pronunciation and retention of vocabulary.

As Historians we will be...

Our local history in Plymouth specifically focusing on the Mayflower, the journey they took and the passengers on board. We will be considering why this is important to us and how Plymouth was significant in this.

As designers we will be...

Creating mood lighting following a design brief such as a torch or a night light.

As artists we will be...

Creating still life drawings based on our favourite things.

In PSHE we will be...

Completing the unit called 'Relationships' and 'Changing me' This will enable us to build on our previous learning about friendships and understand how we change as we get older.
