

**As writers, we will be...**

Continuing to develop our handwriting and presentation and our understanding and knowledge of the different types of sentence structures and their effects. We will be completing a 'Mystery Story' where we will build suspense through empty words and short snappy sentences. We will also be focusing on relative clauses, repetition for effect, complex sentences, adverbial phrases and rich, appropriate vocabulary.

**As mathematicians, we will be...**

Building on our knowledge of place value looking at numbers up to 1000000 and partitioning these and comparing and ordering them. We will also build on from our previous work on addition and subtraction to further develop this skill.

**As religious explorers, we will be...**

Further developing our knowledge of Hinduism particularly looking at the different artefacts used to help them express their beliefs. We will look at their gods, ultimate reality, the Trimurti and different acts of worship that they carry out.

**As artists we will be...**

Looking at illustrative art. This will allow us to understand what this is and then use examples to create our own comic to illustrate a story.

Using our VIPERS skills to tackle questions based on a variety of texts. We will be reading Street Child as our class text.

**In computing, we will be...**

Gaining a greater understanding safety particularly thinking of the impact that sharing digital content can have; understand what appropriate and inappropriate content is; and question 'who I tell if I see something online that make me feel upset', 'why passwords are important', and 'why it is important to reference sources in all my work'.

**As Geographers, we will be...**

Investigating world trade. Through this we will understand what trade is and how resources are distributed around the world. We will also look at fairtrade and why this is so important.

**As scientists, we will be...**

Focusing on chemistry looking at separating materials. We will be looking at what makes a mixture and what makes a pure substance. We will look at what solubility is and how changes can be reversible and irreversible. We will then experiment with different methods to separate mixtures.

**In PSHE, we will be...**

Completing a topic called Being Me. Within this we will think about having a growth mindset, setting goals, how we fit into our country. We will also think about our responsibilities and rewards and consequences.

**As athletes, we will be...**

Developing our dance knowledge and creating routines linked to our historical topics of Romans. We will also be looking at multi skills for our outdoor PE. Developing different skills including teamwork.
